Abstract:

Over the course of nine months in 2017 the PCOM library transformed a study room that had stationary desks and little technology into a dynamic collaborative workspace that includes a 55 inch touchscreen monitor and desktop computer. The steps taken to achieve this included buying new mobile furniture, installing the touchscreen monitor and corresponding equipment, painting the room, and creating support materials including a LibGuide and kit that can be circulated.
